

THE DANG THEATRE AND DANCE SYLLABUS (DTDS) IDENTIFICATION OF CANDIDATES POLICY

Introduction

The Dang Theatre and Dance syllabus are required by their awarding organisation, RSL Awards, to ensure that all examination candidates and accurately identified. This policy applies to all graded examinations.

Issue and review

The date of issue of this policy is January 2023. This policy will be reviewed annually in January of each preceding year.

Candidates Up to Grade 5

The examiner will confirm the identity of the candidate at the start of the examination.

Grade 6 and above

All candidates will be required to present a valid form of photographic identification to the examiner at the start of their examination. For live video exams the candidate will show their identification to the teacher conducting the sessions and to the camera screen at the start. For recorded exams the candidate will be required to show their ID clearly to the screen when introducing themselves.

The following forms of identification are permissible:

- Passport
- Driving Licence
- Travel Pass
- ID Card



Candidates who do not have a valid photographic ID must complete an application. Teachers should contact the Head Office and request the necessary forms.

Examiners will take note of whether identification has been provided on the exam paperwork.

If ID is not provided on the day, it must be submitted to the Exams Department within 24 hours of the exam taking place.

The Dang Theatre and Dance Syllabus reserves the right to withhold any examination results if photographic ID is not provided.
